

## Q&A WITH SUA

### **Question:**

I am already in college, and I want to apply to SUA. Can I transfer credits? Do I still have to take the SAT or ACT test?

### **Answer:**

Students with previous college credits are encouraged to apply to SUA, but all students entering in fall 2001 will be coming in as freshmen—because that is the only class SUA will have its first year!

Students who have already completed 60 college credits or who have graduated from a community college or four-year university will have the option to omit the SAT or ACT test. But students should evaluate this option carefully, because strong SAT or ACT scores can be a favorable factor in the application process.

### **Question:**

I am a native speaker of English from outside the United States. Do I still have to take TOEFL? Do I have to take the SAT?

### **Answer:**

Native speakers of English do not need to take TOEFL if they have graduated from a high school where English is the first language of instruction.

It is recommended, but not required, that all international students take the SAT.
