Named scholarships at SUA start at the \$20,000 donation level, but families or groups may establish one with an initial smaller donation and contribute to the fund, as they are able. When the fund reaches the \$20,000 level, scholarships from the interest generated by the fund will begin to be awarded.

"We established the Hi-deko H. Asawa Memorial Scholarship Fund gradually with donations from our family and friends," notes Ed's son Arch, who is vice president for administrative affairs at the Aliso Viejo campus. "We knew that this gift exemplified our mother's warm heart and love for young people and education...and it is a gift that will keep on giving to students in need for generations to come."
